

# **ND State Electrical Board's Apprenticeship Scholarship Policy for Related Training Students**

At the June 17, 2020, ND State Electrical Board Meeting the following scholarship policy for the education of apprentice electricians enrolled in a board approved North Dakota based related training provider and its approved apprenticeship program was approved by a motion by Tom Paulson and second by Christi Roemmich with the following requirements:

1. A NDSEB recognized North Dakota approved related training program provider would receive educational training dollars up to \$500.00 per enrolled apprentice per semester (max 2 semesters per calendar year).
2. A related training provider with an approved apprentice program may apply to the board to receive scholarship funds and use these funds to purchase books and materials that are only used to train and educate the apprentice.
3. The related training provider must show proof of purchasing the educational materials for the current year's classes.
4. The funds will be available only from the board's education fund unless this fund has been exhausted.
5. The provider will deliver to the board each semester a list of its students and provide records for the following board requirements:
  - a. The apprentice is a resident of ND
  - b. The apprentice works in the jurisdiction of the NDSEB
  - c. The apprentice is employed by a North Dakota based electrical contractor
  - d. The apprentice continuously has been registered as an apprentice with the NDSEB
  - e. The apprentice is enrolled in a board approved related training electrical apprenticeship program
  - f. The apprentice must have and maintain a minimum of a 2.5 grade point average from the previous semester (including incoming from a high school)
  - g. If an apprentice fails a semester funds will not be available for the apprentice until a 2.5 grade point is achieved.
